

SERVICE AND TESTING SCHEDULE SCUBA



The schedule shows the minimum level of service and testing recommended by Interspiro. Local requirements and regulations may deviate from this and set higher requirements. Consideration must also be given to the environment of use and how often the apparatus is used. Frequent use and/or use in harmful environments may require shorter intervals.
